

NEWPORT TATTOO REMOVAL

POST CARE REGIMEN

AFTER CARE:

- Keep the area covered with bandage placed by provider for the first 24 hours.
- Immediately after your treatment you may apply ice packs to minimize swelling, discomfort, and your chance of blistering.
- Avoid using rubbing alcohol or hydrogen peroxide as this can delay healing.
- After 12-24 hours you may shower as usual. Cleanse the area daily with mild soap and water and pat dry. Do not soak in baths/hot tubs/pools/ocean until all blistering and scabbing has healed
 - Days 1-3: Apply Aquaphor or Nove Laser Gel 2-3 times daily
 - Day 4: You may switch to aloe vera or gentle moisturizer of your choice multiple times throughout each day for the duration of your treatments. This will lead to faster healing and removal!

BLISTERS:

- Blistering may occur between 1 to 3 days after treatment. If blistering occurs, keep the area moist with aquaphor. Do not pick at or pop blisters. Please come into the office if large blisters develop so that we may treat them appropriately. After blisters drain, you should apply an antibiotic ointment, such as Neosporin.

ITCHING:

- You may apply hydrocortisone cream or Roman chamomile oil to calm itching that may occur as the tattoo is healing.

AVOID SUN EXPOSURE:

- Use SPF 45 or higher. Apply to your tattoo every 2 hours or keep covered if sun exposure is unavoidable.

Contact Newport Tattoo Removal if there are any signs of infection (yellow crusting, oozing, or redness that is spreading) or if you have any questions.
